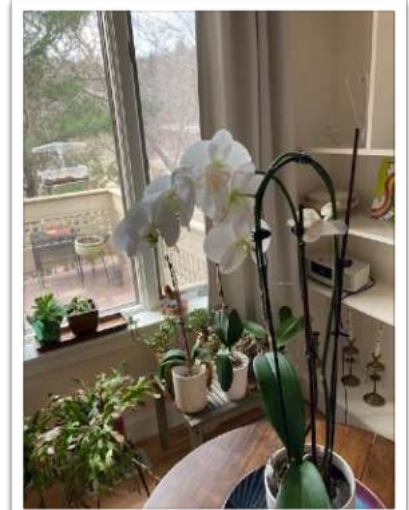
GARDENING ON THE TOWN COMMON
