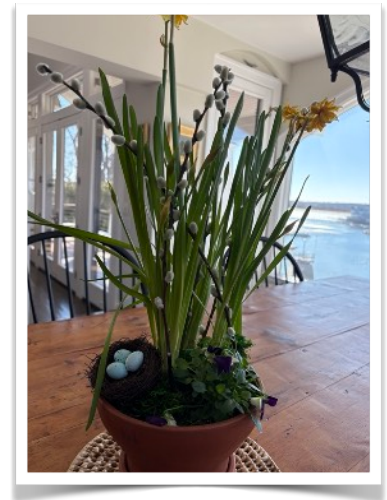
May 21- **Spring Luncheon** at Winchester Country Club **"Pretty in Pink"**
